Incident Description : The Cyberabad Police arrested two employees from a cargo service company on 13th Mar 2015 for the theft of gold ornaments weighing 4.8kg. This Rs 1.20 crore worth of gold was allegedly stolen from Shamshabad airport in Feb 2015. The experienced employees knew that details of the cargo and shipment. They stole one parcel from the consignment of 132 and then entered in the cargo register of receiving only 131. They then took the parcel to their residence and shared the spoils. Airport police received complains on the incident and carried out an investigation before nabbing them and recovering the entire stolen property.
