Thefts involving the stealing of cable and vehicle parts in industrial areas were reported. Two locals involved in the mentioned thefts were arrested following a report on theft on copper cables worth RM 154,000 and truck batteries summing to RM 1000 in Kg Saguking. The duos will be charged under Section 379A and 379 of the Penal Code.

28 February 2015
Two suspects involved in several break-in cases concerning electrical appliance valued at RM 9310 were arrested. Their accomplices were believed to have fled to mainland Sabah after one of the suspect, masterminded the alleged theft of his employer (electrical company).
