Hijacking, Seremban, Malaysia

Date of Incident : 16 February 2015
Time of Incident : 10am
Incident Type : Hijacking
Attempt : No
Modus Operandi : Violent / Threat with Violence
Incident Description : While at the Seremban-Tampin road near the entrance to TTJ, the shipment lorry was blocked by a grey Toyota Alphard with a man in the driver's seat while an unidentified car behind it carried four men. Two of the hijackers who were armed with axes came out from their vehicle and one of them splashed a liquid believed to be petrol on the lorry driver and **his** attendant. Both victims were then tied up and one of the hijackers dragged the lorry attendant into his car and he was later dumped at KM228 of the North-South Expressway. The lorry driver was dumped at a nearby plant nursery
