General Summary / Overview

Reporting to the Senior Director, Global Security establishes this function for Applied Materials operations in Taiwan. Provide leadership, strategic direction, tactical support and innovative solutions to unique, spontaneous and critical business issues, which influence the safety, security and well being of employees, as well as protecting Applied's physical and intellectual property assets. Serve as key contact and advisor.

Duties/Responsibilities:

Develop and administer a highly outsourced security function in close liaison with CAS, HR, Finance and Legal.

Responsible for innovation and leading change in Security related programs.

Duties include: conduct risk assessments, ensure incident reporting, physical security, guard operations, access control, travel security, investigation of crime and some employee infractions, safety and health oversight, executive protection, etc.

Provide strategic analysis and planning for management on emergency situations, including crisis planning/response, hazard mitigation and business continuity.

Assist with the development, communication and implementation of loss prevention strategies ensuring appropriate control levels are in place and verified for major value assets such as trade secrets, intellectual property, etc.

Direct, conduct and/or coordinate the investigation of crimes committed against Applied Materials or its employees. These may include: misappropriation, theft, industrial espionage, threats, due diligence, computer crimes, competitive intelligence, accidents, claims, conflict of interest, assault, harassment, employee vetting, litigation support, etc.

Provide accurate and timely consultation and advice to management regarding security.

Identify and engage cost effective external resources to provide on-demand security assistance. This includes law enforcement personnel, consultants, private investigators, etc.

Integrate both corporate and geographic management priorities.

Conduct audits to ensure compliance with applicable corporate security and safety standards, policies and procedures.

Administer contract security services as needed.
